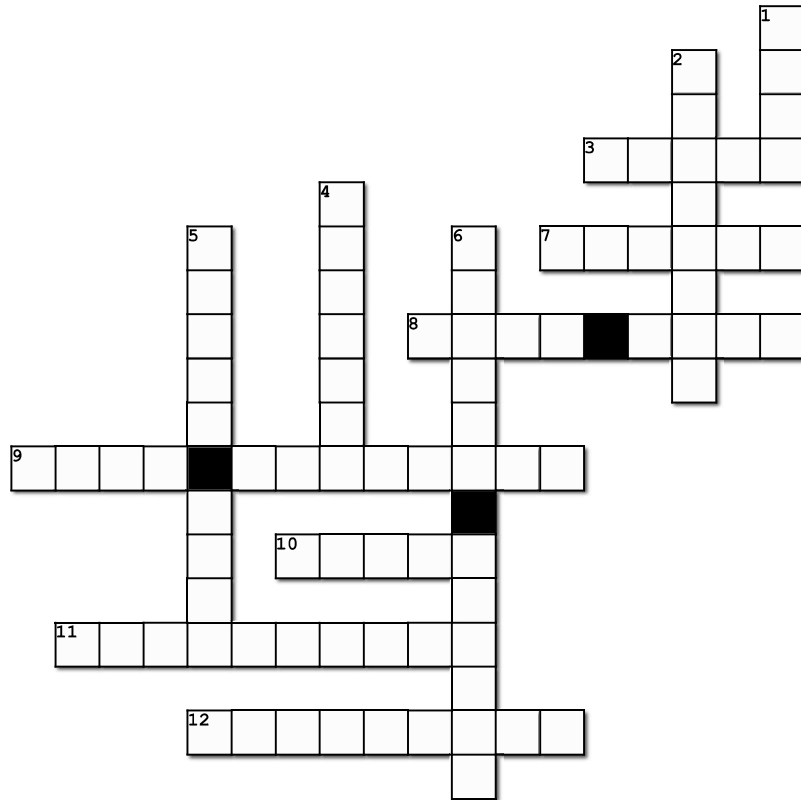


Neurons crossword

Across

- 3. This is a bit like a control centre - it holds our memories, allows us to speak, controls our movement and more!
- 7. A nut that looks like the brain.
- 8. A bit like the 'head' of the neuron, this bit tells the rest of the neuron what to do.
- 9. The 'mouth' of the neuron, where it passes messages on to other neurons.
- 10. The name for the 'building blocks' of our body.
- 11. A piece of equipment which scientists use to look at things that are too small to just see with our eyes.
- 12. A bit like branches, these allow the neuron to 'hear' messages from other neurons.

Down

- 1. Messages travel along this. The myelin sheath is wrapped around it.
- 2. A photo of neurons which have been injected with a chemical so that they glow different colours.
- 4. A machine that scientists use to look inside people's heads and see their brains.
- 5. Neurons are three times thinner than one of these.
- 6. This is wrapped around the axon and helps messages to travel quicker.
