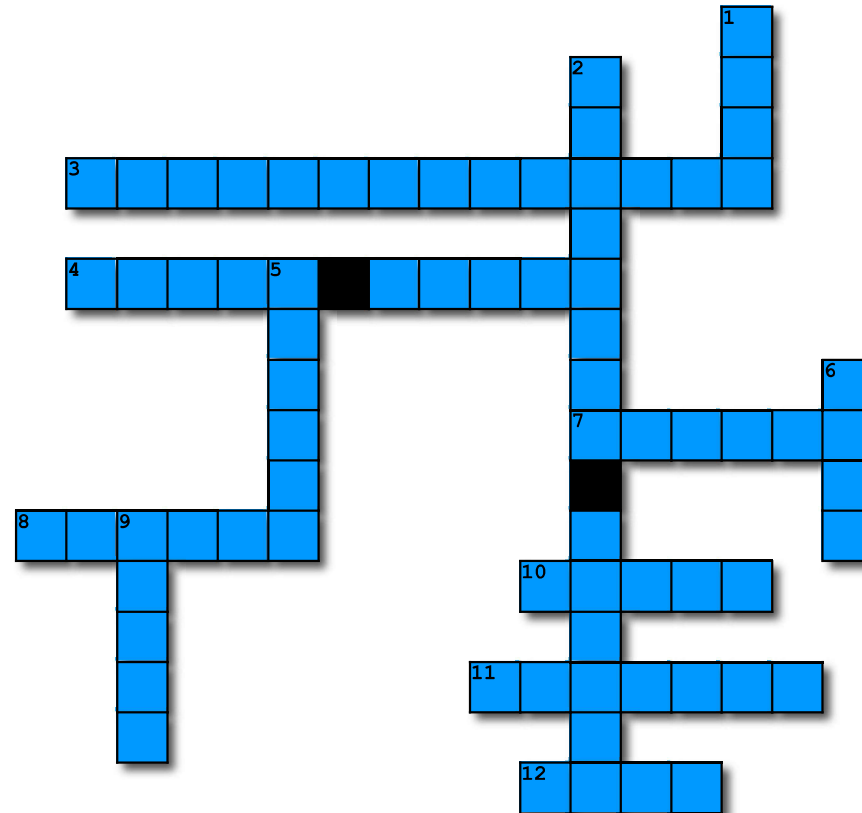


## The eye
