Why join the BNA?

Why bulk registration?

Bulk registration is classed as the registration of 20 or more members to the BNA. Bulk registrations are entitled to a **10% discount** on registration fees. It is a quick and efficient way of registering new students to the BNA.

How does this work?

The institution administrator/course leader is simply required to send a spreadsheet of the names and email addresses of those to be registered to office@bna.org.uk.

The office will then register all students for membership and contact them directly with their account activation link and instructions on how to begin enjoying the benefits of BNA membership.

What about payment?

The BNA office will compile a consolidated invoice for all memberships (**less 10% discount**) and will send this to the responsible person within your institution. Undergraduate membership is just £12 per person per year; postgraduate is £24.
